What and where is North Battleford?



North Battleford (<https://www.cityofnb.ca/>) is the 7th largest city in the province of Saskatchewan and resides approximately 1 hr – 15 min north of Saskatoon. It is nestled just on top of the North Saskatchewan River with lots of beautiful highways for riding. There are a variety of hotels and motels to fit your budget, and a good variety of eating establishments to satisfy almost any craving.

meals arrangements. Hotels and motels identified below are suggestions only. There is plenty to choose from and we suggest you use the internet and google maps to determine and select a hotel suitable to your needs.

Favorable main hotel chains: Many members attending SOR in April stayed at these two main hotel chains with favorable reviews. While a little expensive, they come with a hot breakfast to get you on your way.

Motels – There are many motels as well. Some of them are more basic but also come with a lower price. Usually, breakfast is not included. Please do your diligence in selecting a motel. Members of the North Battleford chapter are recommending the hotels vs the motels.

Hotels/motels to be cautious – it is recommended to not book at the following:

Travelodge by Wyndham – a core hotel/motel rebranded as a Travelodge. It has a less than stellar recommendation by Battleford members.

Battleford Inn Motel – a quaint motel in U shape with parking in front of your room. The concern raised is that it has a bar on site and is very popular as a motel for work crews in the area. Quite possible a nice motel but a quiet and restful sleep may not be guaranteed.

Campgrounds: There are a few campgrounds for those coming with bike trailers or larger RV's. Again, do your research and check reviews. Contact Bill Amundsen (BLB President – 306-441-7316) for more info and reviews.
