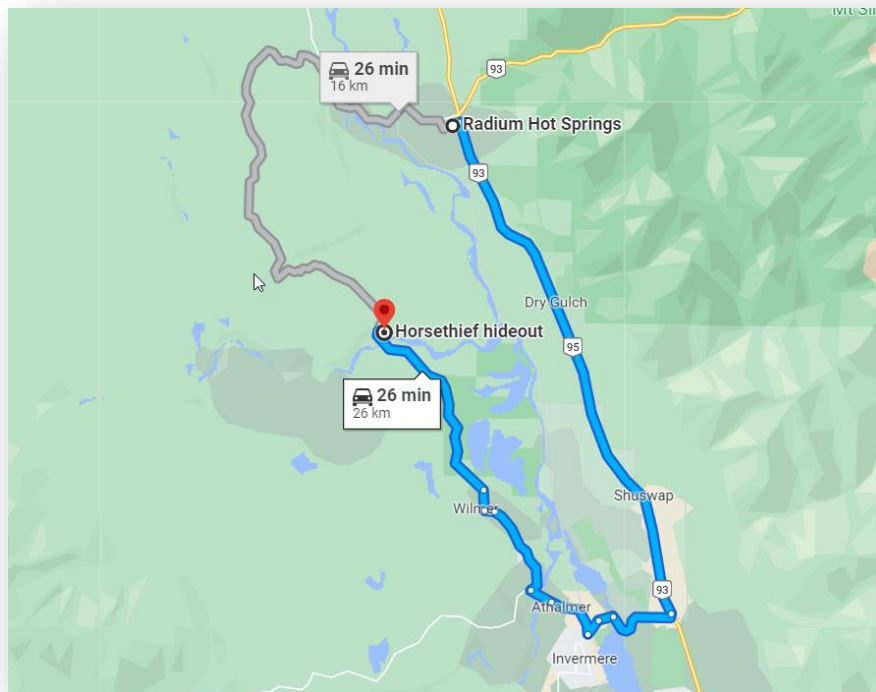

How to get there?

From Radium Hot Springs, Google Maps recommends the road through Invermere. Although here is 10km difference between the two options the travelling duration is the same



Depending on where you live the approach will be different.

In BC

- From Golden BC, take the Highway 95 to Radium
- From Cranbrook, BC take the Highway 93 North towards Invermere

In Alberta

- From Calgary, AB take the Number 1 Highway west and then left onto Highway 93 towards Radium
- From Red Deer, there are 2 options:
 - Head South to Calgary and then #1
 - Head West on Highway 11, left onto Icefields Parkway (Highway 93 South) which leads into Highway 1, then Right onto Highway 93 to Radium

Accommodation



There are two types of accommodation on the property:

- Camping
 1. Tents
 2. RVs and camper trailers - If you are planning to bring a camping trailer or RV, please note that there are no sanitation or electricity hookups. The nearest sani station is down the road in Radium.
- Cabins

There is a total of 8 cabins on the premises which needs to be prebooked through Peter Croft. The cabins consist of:

1. Sleeps 4 - 1 Double Bed, 1 Double Hide-A-Bed (Flushing toilet and shower)
2. Sleeps 4 - 1 Queen Bed and 2 twin beds in a loft (Flushing toilet and shower)
3. Sleeps 2 - 1 Queen Bed (sleep ONLY, NO amenities)
4. Sleeps 4 to 6 - (Motorhome) 1 Queen Bed (separate bedroom) plus the table makes into a bed for 2, and couch makes into a bed for 2 (Sleep ONLY, NO amenities)
5. Sleeps 2 1 Queen Bed (Sleep ONLY, NO amenities)
6. Sleeps 2 1 Queen Bed (Sleep ONLY, NO amenities)
7. Sleeps 2 1 Queen Bed (Sleep ONLY, NO amenities)
8. Sleeps 2 - 1 Queen Bed (Sleep ONLY, NO amenities)
